



## Richard George "Rich" Kinnaman

November 23, 1967 - August 4, 2015

Richard George "Rich" Kinnaman, age 47, died unexpectedly on August 4, 2015 at home of natural causes. Richard was born in Wilmington, DE on Nov. 23, 1967 to Ann Marie and Jack Kinnaman. He graduated from the University of Delaware and earned his master's degree at Temple University. Richard lived in Columbus working for the Fiserv Company as a senior relationship manager.
