Robert Paul Edwards "Bob", 83, of Worthington, OH, passed away on May 24, 2014. Bob was born July 5, 1930 in Glen Ridge, NJ to the late Paul and Dorothy (Roberds) Edwards.

He graduated from Verona High School in NJ where he was Student Council President. Bob attended The Ohio State University, College of Engineering and was a member of Phi Sigma Kappa Fraternity. He graduated from Franklin University.

Bob retired from North American/Rockwell International after 35 years of enjoyable service in Manufacturing, Engineering, Logistics and Customer Relations.
