Robert L. Cox, 83, passed away November 4, 2019, after a long and courageous battle with Parkinson's.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Mary (Dush) Cox and father, Robert E. Cox. He is survived by his loving wife, Janet; daughter, Cynthia (Matthew) Post of Troy, Ohio; son, Brian of Columbus, Ohio; grandchildren, Meredith, Jonathan and Adrienne Post; sisters, Martha (Ray) Ross and Rachel Downing; several nieces, nephews and cousins.

Bob graduated from North High School in Columbus, OH, Milligan College in Milligan College, Tennessee, Kansas City College of Osteopathy and Surgery and became a board-certified physician in Radiology and Nuclear Medicine. He was a radiologist at Doctors Hospital in Columbus for many years. He received the William I. Linder, DO advocate award in recognition of his dedicated support of the osteopathic profession.

Bob served in the Navy Reserves, was a lifelong member of Indianola Church of Christ, Life Member of the American Osteopathic College of Radiology, American Osteopathic Association, Ohio Osteopathic Association, and the Academy of Osteopathic Medicine.

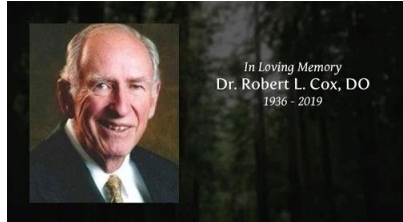
