Robert E. Rommel affectionately known as “Bob” & “Mouse” was 55 years old. He was born February 10th 1962 at St. Albans Military Hospital in St. Albans, Queens, NY. He unexpectedly passed away December 6th 2017 at OSU Medical Center. He resided with his wife of 25 years in Howard, Ohio.

“Bob,” “Mouse,” Rommel proudly served in the United States Marine Corps. After his service, he went on to MIT and graduated with a Bachelors in Computer Sciences along with other degrees.
