Robert J Schafer, 89, of Worthington, Ohio went peacefully to heaven on September 19, 2023. Bob was born October 29, 1933 to Joseph and Betty Schafer in Detroit, Michigan. He married Maura Gallagher on June 23, 1956 in Detroit. Bob received his PhD in Metallurgy in 1963 and worked for a time at NASA in Cleveland before going to work for Archer Daniels Midland Co., which became a division of Ashland Chemical Co. In 1973 he and family moved to Worthington and he worked at the Ashland Research Building in Dublin, Ohio. He retired in 1994. He was a devout Catholic.
