Dr. Robert "Doc" Stanley Seiple, D.O., age 86, of Dublin, Ohio, passed away on Thursday, May 23, 2013. He was born to the late Dr. Harvey and Nelle Seiple on May 5, 1927. Dr. Seiple was a graduate of Warren G. Harding High School and served in the United States Navy during WWII. He graduated from Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine, practicing in Ohio for over 40 years. He was the esteemed Vice Speaker of the American Osteopathic Association House of Delegates and Speaker of the Ohio Osteopathic Association for 30 years. He was a member of Pomeroy-Racine Lodge #164, F&AM, a 32nd Degree Mason, Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite-Valley of Columbus and member of the Aladdin Temple Shrine.
