Roger Starkey, age 70, died peacefully on Friday, February 22, 2013 at his home in Westerville, Ohio. Roger was born in Middletown, Ohio to Roger and Phyllis Starkey. Roger grew up in Middletown, graduating from Middletown High School in 1960. He attended Wilmington College where he played football and was president of Gamma Phi Gamma fraternity. Roger earned a BS in Biology and Chemistry from Wilmington College in 1964 and later received a MBA from Xavier University. His combined education in science and business led to a career with several chemical companies including Ashland Chemical/Sherex Chemical and Solvay Enzymes. Roger was an active parishioner of St. Joan of Arc Church, participating in several ministries, the Men's Club and altar service. He was an avid OSU fan and loved sports. Roger was dedicated to his family, faith, and friends, and was widely known and loved for his humor, kindness and generosity. He was preceded in death by his parents and his father-in-law Ed Sullivan.
