Ronald A. Hibbard, 76, of Columbus, Ohio passed away peacefully on June 17, 2024, after a lengthy battle with cancer at home in Columbus, Ohio. Ron was preceded in death by his parents, Merlin and Ethel Hibbard, and infant twin brothers Tommy and Teddy. He is survived by his devoted and caring wife of 43 years, Karen Sue Hibbard. In his high school days, he was known for his dancing, roller skating and his many part-time jobs. At an early age, Ron displayed the strong work ethic he would carry throughout his life. After high school, Ron attended The Ohio State University while working several jobs to earn his degree in education. After a short stint teaching, Ron turned to real estate, which would be his lifetime career. Ron owned Ron Hibbard Realty for many years before shifting his focus to rental properties, which he and Sue owned and managed together. In addition to managing their business, he and Sue enjoyed considerable travel, much of which included their family. Ron loved to watch almost any sport, but his favorite was watching the Cincinnati Reds with Sue, as they rarely missed a game. Ron was also an avid sportsman, spending many summers with his boat and camper on Lake Erie and hunting during the

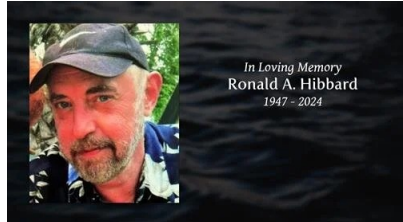
