August 24, 1942 - January 17, 2025

ROSELYN ANN KISTLER, 82, OF POWELL, OHIO, WENT TO BE WITH THE LORD ON JANUARY 17, 2025 AT 1:26 PM FOLLOWING A BATTLE WITH LYMPHOMA, BEGINNING IN 2019. SHE PASSED PEACEFULLY, SURROUNDED BY HER LOVING FAMILY, AT THE KOBACKER HOUSE IN COLUMBUS, OHIO. ROSELYN WAS KNOWN AS A LOVING WIFE, MOTHER & GRANDMOTHER, WHO LOVED HER FAMILY IMMENSELY.

ROSELYN WAS BORN ON AUGUST 24, 1942 IN LEIPSIC, OHIO. SHE GRADUATED FROM MILLER CITY (OHIO) HIGH SCHOOL AND MARRIED THE LOVE OF HER LIFE, CHARLES (CHUCK) KISTLER ON AUGUST 1, 1964. THEY BUILT A BEAUTIFUL LIFE IN 60 YEARS OF MARRIAGE. CHUCK WOULD OFTEN SAY, "SHE'S A KEEPER".

THROUGHOUT HER LIFE, SHE FOUND PLEASURE IN THE OUTDOORS. SHE LOVED TO WATER SKI, FISH, CAMP, & SNOW SKI. WHEN HOME, SHE FOUND PRIDE IN HER GARDEN AND BLUE BIRDS. ROSELYN HAD AN IMMENSE LOVE FOR HER YARD AND TENDING TO HER MANY FLOWERS AND PLANTS. EVERYDAY SHE WOULD ENSURE HER BACKYARD BLUE BIRDS WERE PROPERLY FED AND HAD A COZY BOX TO NEST IN. YEAR AFTER YEAR, MANY BABY BLUE BIRDS HATCHED IN HER CARE.

AN AVID SPORTS FAN, ROSELYN ALSO LOVED TO WATCH SPORTS ON TV, ESPECIALLY THE OSU FOOTBALL TEAM. IF YOUR HOUSE WAS CLOSE BY, YOU COULD SURELY HEAR HER OUTSIDE CHEERING FOR THE BUCKS!!! IN HER YOUNGER YEARS, SHE PLAYED BASKETBALL & SOFTBALL. ROSELYN WAS QUITE COMPETITIVE & WAS KNOWN AS "CRACKLIN ROSIE" ON HER SOFTBALL TEAM.

ROSELYN WAS ALSO WELL KNOWN AS AN INCREDIBLE COOK. HER HOMEMADE BUCKEYE BALLS ARE A FAMILY FAVORITE AND NEVER LASTED LONG. SHE FOUND IMMENSE JOY IN HOSTING FAMILY AT HER HOUSE AND INSISTED ON

COOKING ALMOST EVERY DISH. BEING ONE OF SEVEN CHILDREN, THERE WAS ALWAYS PLENTY OF CHATTER TO GO AROUND. SURROUNDED BY FAMILY WAS WHAT BROUGHT ROSELYN THE MOST JOY.

SHE AND CHUCK LOVED TO CAMP, BOAT AND TRAVEL THE U.S. AND EUROPE. THEY SPENT MANY WINTERS IN VENICE, FLORIDA AND LOVED TO WALK THE BEACH FOR SEA SHELLS AND ANCIENT SHARKS TEETH.
