Russell W. Nippa, 94, died Wednesday, July 8, 2020 in Columbus Ohio. He is survived by his loving wife, Joan, with whom he was married for 69 years; sons Mark (Pamela), Paul (Doris) and David (Jeanie); eight grandchildren and one great-granddaughter. Russell was born and raised in Detroit, Michigan and graduated from Redford High School. He honorably served our country in the US Navy during World War II. Following the war, he met and married Joan, they started their family, and he began a long-time career with Sears, Roebuck and Co., from which he retired at age 63. Throughout his career he was transferred to multiple towns in states including Michigan, Minnesota, Illinois and Ohio. He has lived in Dublin, Ohio for the past 38 years. He was a kind, energetic, and hard-working man who had many friends and was devoted to his family. He enjoyed his retirement years volunteering at New Hope Church, traveling with his wife, visiting with friends, and spending time with his children and grandchildren. He will be greatly missed.
