Sandra Lee Schupp, 76, of Columbus, Ohio and Winter Garden, FL passed on January 1, 2020 after a courageous battle with ovarian cancer. Sandy was born in Salem, MA and spent her childhood in Madeira, OH, graduating from Madeira HS in 1961 and received her Associates Degree in business from University of Cincinnati. Sandy went on to have a very successful 40 year career in real estate with HER Columbus and Berkshire Hathaway in Florida during which she was named rookie of the year in 1980, Realtor of the Year in 1996, and served as chapter president, state president and governor's council member of the Women's Council of Realtors, and reached the status of realtor emeritus award with the National Association of Realtors. 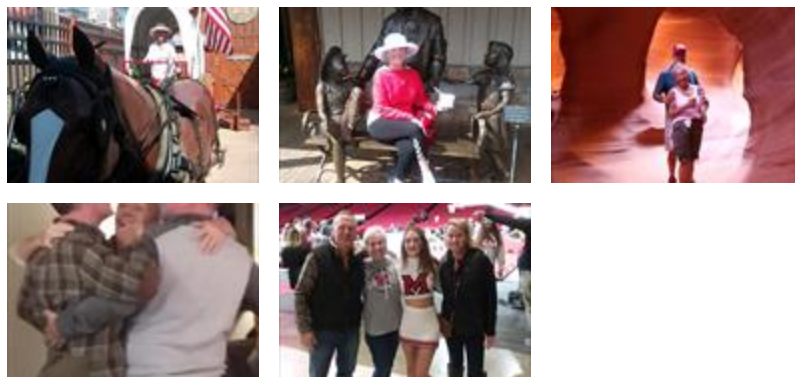
