



## Sarah Mae Wilson

April 18, 1929 - September 3, 2021

Sarah Mae (Martin) Wilson, age 92, of Columbus, Ohio, and formerly of Lewis Center, Ohio, passed away on September 3, 2021.

Sarah was born April 18, 1929, in Lima, Ohio, to the late George Martin and Hazel Evelyn (Graham) Kuhn. She is survived by her loving husband of 72 years, Henry Roy Wilson; daughters E. 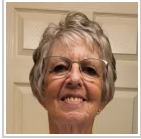
