Stanley Patrick Bednarczyk, Jr. passed away at his home on December 15, 2021. He was born in Carbondale, PA, on August 15, 1947, to Stanley P. Bednarczyk, Sr. and Irene (Bambera) Bednarczyk. He was a graduate of Hackensack High School in Hackensack, New Jersey. He is preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Patrick D. Bednarczyk, of Staunton, VA.
