Stephen Donald (Don) Bundy, 96, passed away at his home at Story Point Powell North on Monday, May 20, 2024.

Don was born in Pittsburgh, PA and resided in the Columbus, Ohio area since 1976. Don was married to Joan Catherine Geiger on June 13, 1953. Don was a devoted husband for 67 years prior to Joan's death on February 19, 2020.
