Susan J Clark died on Thursday, May 17, 2024 at Wesley Glen Retirement Community in Columbus, Ohio.

Born on February 29, 1936 in Freeport, Ohio, Sue was the daughter of the late Arthur H "Brady" Milleson and Mary G Kinsey Milleson.

She was a 1954 graduate of Freeport High School and attended college at The Ohio State University for several years. She was a member of Zeta Tau Alpha, a national women's fraternity. She met her future husband Gordon M Clark at OSU and will always be a Buckeye.

Sue and Gordon married on June 16, 1957, and they were married for 65 years. During that time, they lived in Camp Lejune, North Carolina, Barstow, California, Cleveland, Ohio, Canoga Park, California, Columbus, Ohio and finally settled in Worthington, Ohio where they raised their 2 children.

She was president of the Worthington Women's Club from 2002-2003, president of Presbyterian Women United from 2004-2006 and president of University Women's Club in 2009. Sue also loved to play the piano and sing.
