Susan Kathleen Mosher died unexpectedly at home in Lewis Center, Ohio on January 27, 2015 at the age of 45. Susan is survived by her parents, Mary Rockman of Lewis Center, Ohio and David Rockman of Warren, Ohio; husband, Cary Mosher; daughter, Ashley Mosher; son, Aaron Mosher; brother, John Rockman of Powell, Ohio and sister, Linda Hopsicker of Littleton, Colorado. 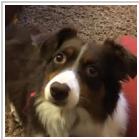
