



Swaminathan Jayaraman

March 16, 1938 - December 19, 2021

Swaminathan “Jay” Jayaraman passed away peacefully at his home on Dec 19, 2021 at the age of 83. Jay led a full, rewarding life that grew from a simple upbringing in a family of 5 in Tiruchirappalli, India, to emigrating to the United States in the mid-1970s where he established roots with his wife Seetha and their son Gautham. He earned his PhD in nuclear physics and went on to pursue a four-decade career in radiology which spanned working in hospitals as well as teaching at institutions of higher education.

Jay was most proud of his family. He is survived by his wife of 49 years, Seetha; one son, Gautham, and his wife Ginger and their three children, Savitha, Sahana and Kalyan. Jay’s sister, Kalyani, her husband Ramani, and their daughter Akila were always in Jay’s thoughts and he spent countless time and resources to help ensure that his successes were shared with those closest to home. Jay always spoke highly and with pride of his two nephews, Raghu and Mouli and their families and wished that they could always be closer.

Jay will always be remembered as an incredibly kind and gentle person. He gave so much, expecting nothing in return. His love of his family and friends was limitless and unconditional. We will never forget his unique sense of humor, his smile, his laugh and his love of clipping coupons, playing cards and watching CNN.
