Talma Aubrey Scott III, 65, of Worthington died suddenly on Tuesday, March 2, 2010 at the Cleveland Clinic due to complications following lung transplantation. Aubrey graduated from the Jamesville-Dewitt Central School in Dewitt, NY and was a graduate of Syracuse University with a BA in Philosophy. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army where he trained as a helicopter pilot and Air Traffic Controller. After 20 years with the Anheuser-Busch Brewery, Columbus, Ohio, he retired in 1999. Aubrey was an avid golfer and a member of Blackhawk Golf Club. He was a "Candidate Master" chess player and a member of the United States Chess Federation and the (ICC) Internet Chess Club.
