Tarry Lee Frasher, sunrise December 18, 1958 to sunset March 12, 2016 after a courageous battle with lung cancer. The eldest of three girls, Tarry was a 1976 graduate of Whetstone High School and later graduated from Columbus State. She was preceded in death by her father Lee Hinder. Tarry is survived by her beloved husband of 28 years Tony Frasher, her family pets, mother Sally Hinder, sisters Tina Maki of Gahanna and Vickie (Mark) Pifer of Dublin, brother-in-law Rod (Diane) of Westerville, sister-in-law Micki of Westerville, nieces Brandy Pifer, Ashley Pifer, Jill Mahle, Stephanie Greenwald, Katie Schreiber and Kelly Gray; nephews Clay Pifer, Colin Maki, Jason Frasher, Drew Belpedio and Matt Garrison. Tarry owned her own business, Miss T's Promotions for 20+ years and in that time developed a strong bond with many people from Special Olympics. Tarry and Tony routinely participated in volunteer opportunities for Special Olympics which she thoroughly loved. Tarry was also a champion in recruiting helpers for Special Olympics cash drops and parking events. She loved working in her yard and was so proud of her flowers. She was always asking people if they wanted some of her florets, grasses or crocus bulbs. Tarry's other great love was animals. Many times she would collect the feral cats in her neighborhood-which required a lot of trapping and cornering. She then made it her personal mission to find them good homes. Tarry always fed the rabbits apples that she had cut up in tiny little pieces and placed just so in the back yard. Tarry's favorite place was the ocean where she spent morning and afternoon searching for shells consistent

with the tides and then watched the sunset. She also was a collector of lighthouses and dolphin figurines. Tarry was an avid Buckeye and Bengal's Fan. She enjoyed her scratch-offs and the casino. She leaves behind her family, friends and neighbors who have great memories of her- always with a laugh and a smile, and always leaving those around her with warmth in their hearts.
