The Reverend Mr. Charles K. Kuck, of Powell, OH, born in 1942 died suddenly Sunday, April 21, 2013 at Riverside Methodist Hospital. He was an ordained minister of the United Church of Christ and served churches in Irondequoit, NY, Akron, OH, Berea, OH and the Dublin Community United Church of Christ in Dublin, OH. He also served as Chaplain to the St. Paul Blvd. Fire Department, Berea Fire Department and as Senior Police Chaplain, Dublin Division of Police. Chuck also held many offices throughout the Association, Conference and National church. He was the son of the late Edna Mary (Fledderjohann) Kuck and Dr. Julius W. Kuck. He is survived by his beloved wife Judith S. Kuck, daughter Mary K. (Christian) Kalix of Powell, son Matthew C. (Tiffany) Kuck of Dublin, and his four grandchildren: Amber and Caroline Kalix and Isabel and Adyson Kuck. He is also survived by his brothers: Dr. Mark A. (Valerie) Kuck of Upper Montclair, NJ and Cmdr. Donald L. (Mary) Kuck, US Navy, Retired, the late John M. Kuck; and nieces and nephews. He was a graduate of Heidelberg College, Tiffin, OH and Colgate-Rochester Divinity School in Rochester, NY. A Memorial Service will be held 2:00pm.
