



Thomas Edward Cassady

December 19, 1942 - May 10, 2020

Thomas Edward Cassady, age 77, of Columbus, Ohio, passed away Sunday May 10, 2020 at his residence surrounded by his family.

Tom was born in Marietta, Ohio on December 19, 1942. He was born to the late Grace Cassady. He is survived by his loving wife, Carolyn, and his children Tom Weihl and wife Jill, Dr. Todd Weihl and wife Missi, daughter Carrie, and his brother Larry Cassady and Shirley. Tom has many grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces and nephews and many friends.

Tom graduated from Marietta Senior High School where he was a standout athlete on the golf team. He started his golfing career at a young age as a caddie at Marietta Country Club. Later he became an assistant pro with Bob Bisciotti at Pickaway Country Club in Circleville, Ohio, and eventually became the head golf pro. At the pinnacle of his golfing career, Tom played on the PGA Tour for 3 years. His best tournament was the Memphis Open where he shot a second round score of 64 tying Jack Nicklaus and finished in the top 20 for the tournament. After his tour career, he regained his amateur status and started his journey in the development business with Day Brothers Development Company as a general partner. In 1988, Day Brothers, Tom, and his brother Larry Cassady partnered to build Shamrock Golf Club in Powell, Ohio. After opening Shamrock in 1989, they went on to help build Wedgewood Golf and Country Club. Tom and his brother Larry also teamed with Charlie Ruma in 1992 to create Jefferson Golf and Country Club. After leaving Day Brothers, Tom formed his own development company and developed Darby Lakes west of Hilliard. He was involved in several other development projects until his death.
