Thomas “Tom” James Homon, 74, of Dublin, Ohio, passed away, surrounded by family, on Thursday, December 14th, 2017. He was born January 22, 1943, in Chicopee, Massachusetts, to the late Albert and Annette (Davignon) Homon. Tom graduated from Worcester Polytechnic Institute in Worcester, Massachusetts, with a BS in mechanical engineering and was a member of Alpha Tau Omega fraternity. Right out of college, he went to work for Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company. He spent his entire career there, 36 years, ending up as General Manager of Conveyor Belt. He especially liked working with and training young people. Tom valued and enjoyed the Goodyear employees and customers he worked with through the many years. Tom was unsure of how life would go in retirement, but after a few weeks, he announced, “I was born to be retired.” He loved playing golf several times a week at Mill Creek Golf Club, Rolling Meadows Golf Club (where he was lucky (or skilled) enough to score two holes-in-one), and other courses around the state. In retirement he also fly fished for trout at Briarwood Sporting Club (he never ate any trout, but brought it home for others to enjoy). His three sons and their families all live within three miles, and Tom loved being around them and going to the grandchildren’s’ events. He is survived by his loving wife Carol (Benham); his sons, James (Julie), Patrick (Elizabeth), and Todd; three grandchildren, Andrew Homon, Jackson Homon, and Ainsley Homon. He is also survived by his sister, Carol Ann Homon (Melvie), and brother, Ken (Barbara) Homon, sisters and brothers-in-law, Judy and Steve Weinstein,
