Pastor Thomas S. Patesel, age 63, of Reynoldsburg, went home to be with Lord on Monday, February 4, 2008, at Grant Medical Center. He was the senior Pastor of Believers' Baptist Church, a church which he started, for the last thirty years, and headed one of the largest prison ministries in the State of Ohio. He was also a U.S. Air Force Veteran serving during the Vietnam Era. He was preceded in death by his parents Robert D. and Shirley A. (Dobbins) Patesel.
