May 19, 1937 - September 4, 2016

Thomas Edwin Sloan was born May 19, 1937 in Loveland, Ohio to Albert T. Sloan, Jr. and Oleatha Fouts Sloan. He was educated in the Loveland Schools and graduated from Miami University with a BA degree in chemistry. Following graduate work at Ohio State University, he rose to senior editor at Chemical Abstracts Service. His specialty became the nomenclature of inorganic compounds. Through this work he served for fifteen years on international nomenclature committees. He retired in 2000. Preceded in death by his parents and brother Gordon he died at home on Sunday, September 4, 2016. He is survived by Ruth, his wife of fifty-seven years. Also surviving are his well-loved children and their spouses, Stephanie and Kurt Henderson of Westerville, Peter and Bobbie Sloan of Finneytown, Ohio and Paul and Paula Sloan of Gahanna.
