It is our profound regret to announce that Tri Vo passed away on July 31st after battling an illness during hospitalization for the past month. Tri was 54 years old. He was born in Vietnam to Minh Vo and Nguyet Trang. Tri escaped to America just prior to the end of the Vietnam war at the age of seven. Tri was a union steward and recording secretary for Volvo Trucks Distribution Center.

Tri was known for his high intelligence, sharp wit, and ability to charm just about anyone from any background. He could engage you on any topic, and he enjoyed challenging his facebook followers with political provocations. Tri was gifted at telling stories, and he used his talents to engage groups of friends in playing characters in Dungeons & Dragons and other role playing games. 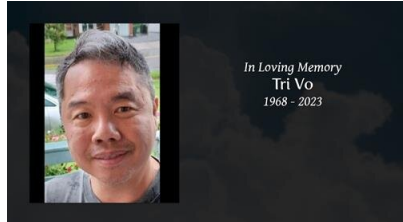

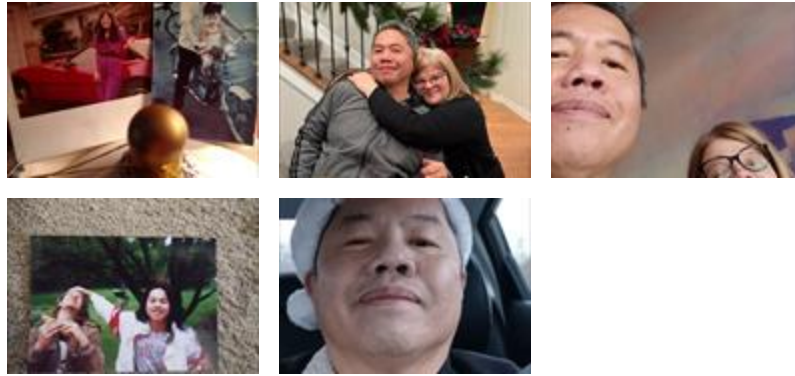
