Vanessa Gail Bing, 70, of Mount Gilead, Ohio, passed away peacefully in her sleep on January 18, 2026. Born January 16, 1956, in Logan, West Virginia to Lester and Charlotte Bing, she was raised in Columbus, Ohio. Despite early challenges with undiagnosed dyslexia, she developed a lifelong appreciation for reading.

Vanessa married Robert Christopher Souder in 1972, and they welcomed their son, Robert Wayne Souder, in 1974. After their divorce, she married Michael Stalter, with whom she continued to raise Wayne, supported greatly by her parents. Later, Vanessa partnered with Andrew Brummel, and together they traveled the country as a long-haul trucking team.
