REYNOLDS Virginia Rader Reynolds, 99, of Columbus, OH, died peacefully on September 21, 2008. She was a member and leader of many professional organizations and an ardent Buckeye fan. Virginia was a devoted member of King Ave. United Methodist Church for 63 years, singing in the choir, teaching Sunday School, and participating in many groups. Virginia's faith in God made her sweet-spirited, grateful, optimistic, generous, wise and encouraging; her unconditional love, freely given, is her greatest legacy.
