Vivian R. Jachimiak, 95, passed away on February 18, 2015 at Kobacker House in Columbus, Ohio. Vivian was born in Toledo, Ohio January 6, 1920 to Leo and Rose (Gomolski) Czarnecki. She was the second youngest of seven children. Vivian was a life-long Toledoan, who spent a few important mid-life years in Lima, Ohio. Her husband and “best friend,” Al Jachimiak, who was a regional manager for the IRS, preceded her in death in 1997. Survived by brother, Gene Czarnecki (Toledo); children Paul (Peg) Jachimiak, Boulder, CO, Lynne (Greg) Browning, Worthington, Ohio and David (Laura) Jachimiak, Hilton, NY; seven grandchildren and ten great grandchildren. Vivian graduated from Central Catholic High School and Tri-Satae Business School where she met her husband. They married in 1943 in Florida when Al was in the military during World War II. Vivian spent her married life as a wife and mother. She loved nature and animals and passed on this love to all her children. She also enjoyed hiking and golf. As a young woman, Vivian was one of the best female bowlers in Toledo. And her golfing ability was outstanding and included getting six hole-in-ones in sanctioned play. Vivian also enjoyed volunteering as a physical education teacher at her children’s elementary school. Later in life she and Al loved visiting the national parks. In recent years, she enjoyed her life and friends at Wesley Glen Retirement Community, including her exercise classes, library visits and playing scrabble online with her Colorado family members. Through it all she was an avid, lifelong reader and
