HOLBROOK Walter A. Holbrook, M.D., age 86, of Upper Arlington died, November 3, 2011, at Kobacker House in Columbus. Graduated Austintown-Fitch High School (Youngstown, Ohio), OSU and OSU Medical School. He was also a WWII U.S. Navy Veteran. Dr. Holbrook was a family physician in Worthington, Ohio for 46 years, a medical consultant for the Bureau of Disability Determination for 30 plus years, as well as Job and Family Services. He was a member of York Lodge #563 F. & A.M., 32nd Degree Masons, Valley of Columbus, A.A.S.R.; and Aladdin Shriners. He was a Past Deacon and Elder of the Presbyterian Church (Worthington, OH); president Worthington Jaycees, and member of the Worthington Civic Band. Survived by his wife, Karen; mother of his sons, Marion; sons, Alan (Lusia), Jeff (Pattie), Mark (Margie, deceased), Walter, III (Diane); five granddaughters; two grandsons; two great-granddaughters; and other relatives and friends.
