He worked for 5 years as a chemist at Dupont in Wilmington, Delaware and for 34 years for Chemical Abstract Service in Columbus, Ohio. He was chosen for the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) and served for 48 years as a member of the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry (IUPAC) which took him to over 30 countries in Europe, China, and Australia.

He was active in the Boy Scouts of America achieving the rank of Eagle Scout and leader of the BSA troop at Meadow Park Church of God for many years. His musical involvement included singing in musicals in high school, playing the trumpet including performing "TAPS" as a soloist. He loved singing in choirs in Wilmington and at North Broadway Methodist, Overbrook Presbyterian and Bethel Presbyterian churches. He was very involved in Bible Study in the Anselm Institute and completed the full curriculum of the Bible Study Fellowship, International. He was clerk of Session for a term at Overbrook Presbyterian. Of his many hobbies, he most enjoyed playing golf in Chemical Abstracts leagues and taking numerous trips to Myrtle Beach, S.C., with a group of men from Overbrook Presbyterian Church.
