



Wayne Latshaw

October 2, 1930 - November 27, 2023

Wayne Latshaw, age 93 of Columbus, passed away at Riverside Methodist Hospital on Monday, November 27th, 2023. He was born in Somerset, Pennsylvania to the late Charles and Hazel (Brown) Latshaw. He spent his entire career working for Ceco Corporation (later Robertson Ceco) as Region Manager overseeing the building of large concrete and steel structures including hotels, parking garages, and larger projects like Riverfront Stadium in Cincinnati and the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in Cleveland. Best known for his quick wit and sense of humor, he enjoyed his beloved dog Coco, tinkering with cars, projects around the house, and always had one of the best looking yards in the neighborhood. Wayne is preceded in death by wife Shirley Latshaw and survived by his two sons, Douglas Latshaw of Columbus and David Latshaw of Phoenix (Pam); his granddaughter Jillian; his brother, Edward of Guilford Lake; and his sister, Patricia of Somerset.
