Wayne Joseph Rohrbaugh, 61, of Dublin, Ohio, died suddenly at home on Friday, February 12, 2010. Born in York, Pa. to Joe and Mary Rohrbaugh, Wayne was a graduate of York Suburban High School, Class of 1966. He received his Bachelor of Science, Physics, from Drexel University, in Philadelphia in 1971, and his Ph.D, Physical Chemistry, from Iowa State University, in 1977. Wayne was a former professor at Wesley College, Dover, Del., then a Research Chemist at Mobil Oil Corp., a Scientific Manager at ICI Americas, Inc. Later he worked at Ashland Chemical and retired in 2007. In his retirement, Wayne worked at USG in Chicago, Ill., then moved to Cincinnati, Ohio, in January, 2009 to work with Syrgis Performance Products as Chief Technology Officer. He was a member of the American Chemical Society, Analytical Laboratory Manager's Association and Directors of Industrial Research. Wayne was preceded in death by his beloved wife of 38 years, Phyllis Theresa (Leonard) Rohrbaugh, who died in August, 2009. He is survived by his parents, Joe and Mary Rohrbaugh, of York, Pa.; brother, Christian (Judy) Rohrbaugh, of Silver Lake, OH; children, Stephanie Rohrbaugh, of Dublin, Ohio, Michael (Stacey) Rohrbaugh, of Cincinnati, Ohio, Daniel Rohrbaugh, of Galloway, Ohio, and Christine (Jeremy) Combs of Columbus, Ohio; granddaughter, Sara Nicole Combs; mother-in-law, Rose Leonard, of Glenn Mills, Pa.; sisters-in-law, Mary (Andrew) Pfeifer of Ft.
