William P. "Bill" Rutherford, age 91 of Columbus passed away peacefully at home on Sunday, August 24, 2014. He was President and C.E.O. Rutherford Funeral Homes and Crematories and Licensed Funeral Director since 1944. Bill is preceded in death by his loving wife of 70 years, Helen Tracy Rutherford; parents, Perry E. and Ruth Grove Rutherford; brother, Edward E. Rutherford; and sister, Ruth E. "Bee" Green. He is survived by children, W. Arch (Carolyn) Rutherford and J. Lynn (W. He was a life-long member of North United Methodist Church. Bill graduated from North High School in 1940. In addition to his professional, church and charity involvement he shared many adventures with Helen as they traveled the world together. Although he will be greatly missed by those who knew him, his legacy will be carried on through his family, funeral service colleagues, past and present associates of Rutherford Funeral Homes and the many lives that he touched through the years.
