William K. Vaughan, formerly of Columbus and Powell, Ohio, passed away at the VA Hospice Facility in St. Petersburg, Florida on Tuesday, March 27, 2012 at the age of 89. For over 30 years, beginning in 1956, Bill worked as a Civil and Professional Engineer in the Greater Columbus and Delaware communities, contributing to the design and construction of hundreds of public and private structures and infrastructure projects. A graduate of the United States Military Academy, West Point, Class of 1945, he was a Pearl Harbor survivor. Bill and his wife of 54 years, Laura Vaughan who was an elementary school teacher in Upper Arlington for over 20 years, moved to St. Petersburg in 1991. Laura died in 1999. He is survived by his son William Vaughan, Jr., daughter-in-law Joan and three grandchildren. In memory of Bill, the family will be holding a service in the afternoon of SATURDAY, JUNE 23, 2012 at the Chapel of Silver Bay, NY and placing his ashes at Silver Bay Memorial Gardens near the shores of Lake George.
