On June 2, 2021, William Emil LeBorgne, 74, passed away peacefully at his home in Lewis Center, Ohio, with his wife and children by his side.

Bill was born in Passaic, N.J. on October 10, 1946 to the late Jean Louis and Irene (Kravchak) LeBorgne. A graduate of Clifton High School, Bill served in the U.S. Naval Reserves from 1965-1971 and received a National Defense Service Medal for his active duty during Vietnam. 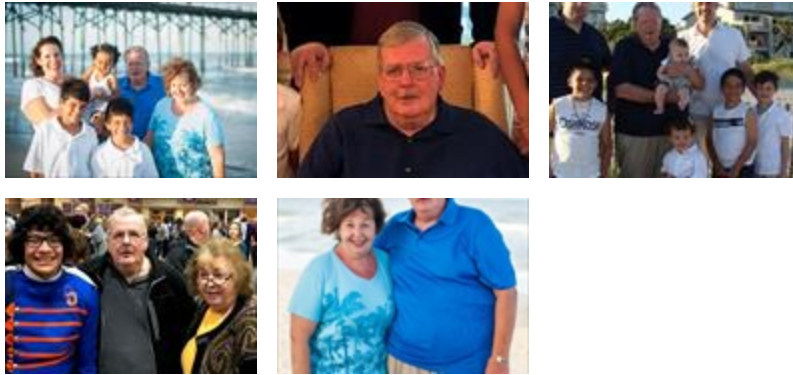
