William H. "Bill" Hamilton III, age 81 of Columbus, passed away on Saturday April 8, 2023 at his home. Bill was born on March 8, 1942 in Dayton to the late William H and Betty (Gustin) Hamilton. Bill was a graduate of Grandview Hts HS, where he was a Rook. After proudly serving his country as a Marine, he went to The Ohio State University where he received a BFA. Bill taught Art in Florida, then back in Ohio he owned Hamilton Design & Associates (graphic design firm), was a professional photographer, and was Creative Director at Highlights For Children. He also worked in the paint dept of The Home Depot, where he was known as "Mister Bill" until he retired at age 80.
