William M. Eddy, devoted husband and father, passed away peacefully and surrounded by family on April 27, 2026, following a brave battle with cancer. He is survived by his wife of 33 years, Brenda Logan Eddy, and their daughter, Morgan Anne Eddy of Powell, Ohio; his parents, Georganne Zaro Eddy and Bob Eddy of Lafayette, California; and his brother Charles Walter Eddy III of Mobile, Alabama. A dedicated resident of the Powell community since 1998, Bill poured his time, talent, and heart into its growth and well-being. In 2004 he founded MidWest Technical Associates at 140 W. Olentangy Street, where he provided technical expertise to thousands of Powell residents — especially seniors and those in need — often giving far more of his time than he ever charged. The City of Powell honored him with a formal Proclamation for his extraordinary service. He was deeply involved with the Powell Chamber of Commerce and served as a leader and organizer of the Saturday Farmers Market, helping make it a beloved community tradition. He also lent his technical skills to Liberty Township and the local fire department, and was an active member of SERTOMA for more than 20 years, supporting civic engagement, community initiatives, and local candidates. A pillar of faith at St. Patrick's Episcopal Church, Bill served on the vestry, mentored and sponsored eight youth confirmands, and established and led the Lenten Fish Fries for over 17 years to build fellowship and raise funds for Habitat for Humanity. During the COVID crisis he created and maintained live-streaming services so the entire congregation could stay connected. Above

all, Bill loved his family, his community, and his God. He kept a sign posted above his computer that read, "Everyone you meet today is dealing with something you have no idea about. Be kind." A Celebration of Life service will be held at St. Patrick's Episcopal Church in Dublin, Ohio, on Saturday, May 30, 2026, at 12:00 noon.
